


Chi's ear gets the party treatment again this week to reflect another highly profitable week for the Recommended Portfolio.

Those Investors long in Alpha or Beta, however, have less to celebrate as both Funds lost all wagers this weekend, leaving the Alpha Fund at around 70c and still without a profitable weekend all season, and the Beta Fund at just over 50c. Details of the current positions of all portfolios are in the table at right.

Surprisal

For only the second time this season just 3 of 8 favourites were successful this weekend, and with three of the victors priced higher than \$3 and another priced at \$2.80, a Round rating of "Unpredictable" seems entirely appropriate.

Indeed, based on surprisals, it was the most unpredictable Round of the season.

This is the third "Unpredictable" this year, and the third time that such a round has been profitable for those with the Recommended Portfolio.

If there was ever any doubt what sort of round Investors with the Recommended Portfolio prefer, the table at right should make it obvious.

Tipping

Surprise and unpredictability is generally associated with poor tipping performances and this is exactly what we had this weekend as the average MAFL tipster managed just 2.37 correct tips, almost one full tip lower than the previous lowest for the season. Only the Geelong and Roos victories were universally expected; every other winner was the minority MAFL tip.

The breakdown of tipster performance appears in the table at right. The weekend's best performance was 5 from 8, recorded by MM5 and MM6, and the worst was 2 from 8, recorded by just about every other tipster.

In overall tipping BKB still leads by 4 and is now on 98 from 136 (72%), followed by Chi on 94 (69%), then CTL, Quila and Shadow on 93 (68%), MM5 on 91 (67%) and MARS on 90 (66%). In last place, still, are MM40, 41 and 44 all on 74 from 128 (54%).

Running totals for all tipsters appear in pictorial form in the Appendix.

The form tipsters over the last 5 rounds have been MM4 and MM5 who've each scored 26 from 40 (65%), narrowly better than Shadow on 25 (67 $\frac{1}{2}$ %). Worst has been MM40 on 17 from 40 (42 $\frac{1}{2}$ %), which is a tipping performance indistinguishable from coin-tossing.

Converting Opportunities

This weekend, two teams lost despite registering more scoring shots than their opponents – the Lions, who had 34 scoring shots to the Tigers' 27, and the Swans, who had 23 scoring shots to Adelaide's 22.

These two bring to 14 the total number of games this year in which the team recording fewer scoring shots has failed to collect the competition points. The table at right has the detail.

Fremantle, remarkably, has been the loser in 4 such games. In fact, of the 8 games in which it has recorded more scoring shots than its opponent, it has won just one-half of them.

Other teams to have lost more than once when recording more scoring shots than their opponents are Adelaide and this week's miscreants, Sydney and Brisbane.

On the flip side, Richmond have won 3 and drawn 1 game when they've recorded fewer scoring shots than their opponents (and won another when they've recorded the same number of scoring shots). It's perhaps not surprising then that the Tigers are 2nd in the competition in terms of Accuracy, with almost 64% of their (non-rushed) scoring shots being goals.

Across the various Alternative Premierships:

- Geelong still leads in 6 Alternative Premierships, comprising all of the End of Quarter Premierships, the During the 1st Quarter and the During the 3rd Quarter Premiership.
- Collingwood continues to lead the During the 2nd Quarter Premiership and Hawthorn leads the During the 4th Quarter Premiership.
- Melbourne retains 7 of the 8 Alternative Premiership Spoons, missing out only in the During the 4th Quarter Premiership, which is now held by the Brisbane Lions, an amazing feat for a side currently in the competition's Top 8.

The worst performances of any team in any quarter are:

- Melbourne in 2nd quarters (1 win and 16 losses)
- West Coast in 2nd quarters (4 wins and 17 losses)
- Melbourne in 1st and 3rd quarters; Carlton, Essendon and St Kilda in 2nd quarters (all 5 wins and 12 losses)

The best performances of any team in any quarter are:

- Collingwood in 2nd quarters (14 wins and 3 losses)
- Geelong in 3rd quarters and Hawthorn in 4th quarters (13 wins and 4 losses), and Western Bulldogs in 2nd quarters (12 wins, 2 draws and 3 losses)

Geelong continues to lead on the overall table, with Sydney now relegated to 3^{rd} , behind the Bulldogs by ½ a quarter. Hawthorn are now in outright 4^{th} ahead of Collingwood.

Melbourne remain last on this table, having won a miserly 26% of the quarters in which they've competed. They now trail 2^{nd} -last placed West Coast by 4 quarters.

The top 8 in this table now match the top 8 on the competition ladder with just a few reorderings the difference.

Not surprisingly then, the correlation between competition points and points in the Total Quarters Won table is +0.93.
