### Results in Review

### MAFL Funds

Three other teams on which we'd made head-to-head bets - the Eagles, the Swans and the Dons – also, it transpired, had chosen this weekend as one during which they should hone their come-from-behind capabilities though each neglected to exhibit what many would characterise as an essential component of such an ability, viz winning. close enough, late enough in the game to offer some hope, but the Dons were pretty much done at the first change.

On Line betting, we lost our only wager, on the Roos, who were unable to stay close enough to the Crows to give our bet any realistic prospects of success for any significant portion of the game.

So, we finished the weekend with 6 winning and 6 losing bets, which produced a 7.4c gain for the Heritage Fund, a 4.7c loss for the Alpha Fund, a 1.7c loss for the Beta Fund, breakeven for the Chi Fund, and a 7.8c loss for the Line Fund.

Whilst no Fund is showing positive returns for the season, the Chi Fund is closest to doing so and is performing pleasingly in its first year of operation having recorded 5 wins and 2 losses.

### **Tipping**

This was a much more difficult round to tip with the average MAFL tipster scoring just 4.77, down over 11/4 tips from last weekend.

The Blues', Dogs' and Dees' victories did most of the damage for many tipsters, and the Crows' win hurt a few more.

Five tipsters nonetheless managed 7 from 8: MM2, MM5, MM6, MM7 and CTL.

The relatively poor performance of many tipsters has spread the leaders out a little leaving BKB in front on 43 from 56 (77%), followed by Chi on 42 from 56 (75%), then MARS two tips back on 40 from 56 (71%), and then four tipsters each on 39 from 56 (70%) - MM2, SUM, CTL and Quila. In last place, on 31 from 56, is MM35. The running totals for all tipsters appear in pictorial form in Appendix 1.

Melbourne, in registering their first competition points of the season, won 2 quarters, almost doubling their season tally and giving them now the  $6^{th}$ -best  $4^{th}$  quarter results amongst all teams in the competition.

The Hawks finally lost a 2<sup>nd</sup> term, but won the 4<sup>th</sup> to preserve their perfect record for that quarter. Amazingly, they've kicked almost twice as many points as their opponents in the final term, a feat that has almost been matched by the Cats despite their having lost one 4<sup>th</sup> term this season.

Carlton won their first final term this week in the course of holding off the Eagles at Subiaco, but still find themselves with an overall record that suggests they'd much prefer shorter contests: they are 2<sup>nd</sup>-best in terms of 1<sup>st</sup> quarters, 7<sup>th</sup>-best in terms of 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters, 14<sup>th</sup> in terms of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarters, and 15<sup>th</sup> in terms of 4<sup>th</sup> quarters.

The table at right shows the number of total quarters won, drawn and lost for every team.

Only two teams' ranking in this table is substantially different from its ranking on the competition ladder:

- St Kilda are now 5<sup>th</sup> on the competition ladder, but they're equal 11<sup>th</sup> here, having won less than half the quarters in which they've competed
- The Lions are 10th on the competition ladder but 7th here having won 14½ of 28 quarters (though only 2½ of 7 final terms)

Historically, over the seasons 2000 to 2007, MARS has enjoyed a significant lift in predictive ability at the end of Round 7, the result being that it has correctly predicted, on average, 6.5 of the 8 finalists at this stage, and has never predicted fewer than 6.

The table at right shows the relative success-rate of teams making the Finals depending on their MARS Ranking after 7 rounds. A few things to note:

- No team rated in the Top 4 by MARS after 7 rounds has subsequently missed the Finals.
- Only two teams rated lower than 11<sup>th</sup> by MARS after 7 rounds have subsequently played in the finals that year (both exceptions were in 2002 when the Roos, ranked 12<sup>th</sup> by MARS, finished 7<sup>th</sup>, and the Eagles, ranked 14<sup>th</sup> by MARS, finished 8<sup>th</sup>. Notably, neither progressed beyond the Elimination Finals).


