### **Hopping Back On The Bike**

Yet again the Heritage and Line Funds have responded to adversity by wading in with significant bets. Even with only three games this weekend, between them they've managed to put over 3% of Strategy A Notional Initial Funds at risk.

Here's the detail:

The Heritage Fund is 0 and 4 on the Tigers this season for a net loss of 31½% (sic) of Notional Initial Funds; the Line Fund is 1 and 0 for a net gain of 7%. On the Pies, the Heritage Fund is 1 and 0 for a net gain of nearly 10%, and the Line Fund is 1 and 1 for a net gain of just over 1%. Suffice to say: the Tigers owe us.

And, again, the timidity of the Alpha and Beta Models is something of a disappointment. Let's hope they find some value over the course of the remainder of the season.

Which makes the profitability equation pretty simple:

- Strategy A, C and E Investors need Richmond to win outright
- Strategy B Investors need Richmond to win outright, or Collingwood and Richmond to win with start
- Strategy D Investors need Collingwood and Richmond to win with start

 BKB, Chi and Quila are in lockstep this weekend, whilst MM16 goes it alone in tipping the Tigers over the Dees.

## **MM16 Tips the Tigers, Alone**

BKB, Chi and Quila all have the same tips for the weekend's three games. MM16 though, whilst sharing two of these tips, is alone amongst all tipsters in choosing the Tigers to beat the Dees. That said, Chi has tipped the Dees by just 4 points and his record is a relatively unimpressive 16 and 13 for teams he's tipped to win by 4 points or fewer. Quila too has tipped the Dees to win by a narrow margin – just 1 point – and she's 4 and 6 for teams she's tipped to win by such a margin (and, I might add, 0 and 5 for teams she's tipped to win by 2 points).

All of which is, hopefully, good news for the Tigers and for the Heritage and Line Fund wagers.

## **Appendix**

### **Tipping Model Strategies**

Strategy Name	Basis for Tips
Chi Tipping Model (CTM)	Complex statistical model incorporating a range of factors.
Quila Tipping Model (QTM)	Uses an approach similar to that used for the CTM.
Bookies Know Best (BKB)	For each game, tips the TAB Sportsbet favourite. In the case of equal favourites, it tips the true home team or, if there's no true home team, tips the team with the higher ladder position (ties are broken using percentage then for-and-against margin).
Consult The Ladder (CTL)	Tips the team with the higher ladder position (ties are broken using percentage then for-and-against margin). For the first round of the season, use the ladder position at the end of the previous regular season.
Momentum Matters (MMx)	A series of strategies that involve building competition ladders based only on the results of the most recent x rounds of regular season games (drawing on games from the previous season if required).
	The MM2 strategy considers only the last 2 regular season rounds, the MM4 strategy only the last 4 rounds, and so on. Once a ladder has been built for a strategy, the selected team is that with the superior ladder position (as per CTL above).
	This year we'll track the performance of MM2, MM4, MM6, MM8, MM11, MM16 and MM22.
No Independent Thought (NIT)	Tips the team that is most popular amongst all other strategies.

### **Notional Initial Funds**

For reasons that are somewhat technical (I'm happy to provide details to anyone who's interested but, broadly, it allows me to describe bets in terms of a common percentage for all Investors and still maintain the same share price for all Investors), I need to calculate what I call "Notional Initial Funds". It's calculated separately for each Fund.

For original Investors, the definition is straightforward:

Notional Initial Funds = Actual Funds Invested

For Investors who join the Fund post Round 1:

Notional Initial Funds = Actual Funds Invested / Share Price at the time of investing

(in other words, it's the notional amount that would need to have been invested at the start of the season in order to have returned an amount equal to the amount actually invested).
